- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 except as specifically noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association will apply except as specifically noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The class rules of each class will apply, except any of those altered by the sailing instructions.
- 1.4 Official Sailing Instructions will be issued to competitors upon payment of registration fees. Any sailing instructions included in this Notice of Race may be modified up to and including time of registration.

**2 ENTRIES**

- 2.1 Participation is by invitation of Kitsilano Yacht Club. Classes invited to participate in 2009 include:

**5o5** – This event is designated the Canadian 5o5 Championship event for 2009 and an additional day of racing is scheduled for 5o5 fleet only on Friday July 10, 2009 as required by the Class. An X-Class may be started at the discretion of the PRO. Portsmouth ratings will NOT be applied to X-Class participants.

- 2.2 Boats may be entered in this regatta by completing registration and payment of fees before 1100 Saturday, July 11, 2009, at the Kitsilano Yacht Club (KYC). Registration is open Thursday, July 9th between 2000 and 2200 and Saturday, July 11<sup>th</sup> between 0930 and 1100 hours.  
KYC can accept payment in Canadian cash, US cash at par or Canadian cheque.

- 2.3 Entrant must be a member in good standing of both their Fleet's Class Association, a Club recognized by their National Authority, and of the Canadian Yachting Association or the corresponding national authority of the entrant's home club.
- 2.4 KYC reserves the right to refuse entry of any person or boat by refunding money paid upon registration.

**2.5** All those taking part in the racing do so at their own risk and responsibility. The hosting organization is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a yacht or for the safety of those whose entry is accepted. Attention of the competitor is drawn to RRS Part 1, Fundamental Rule 4.

### **6.1 Registration:**

Thursday, July 9th between 2000 and 2200 and Saturday, July 11<sup>th</sup> between 0930 and 1100 hours.

A maximum of nine (9) races will be run.

No warning signal will be made later than 1500 on Sunday, July 12.

**7.1** Classes with five or more entries will be scored separately

**7.2** One X Class made up of those Classes that have fewer than five entries may be permitted to race at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer. No handicap scoring will be applied.

**8.1** Prizes will be awarded to each member of the crews placing first, second and third.

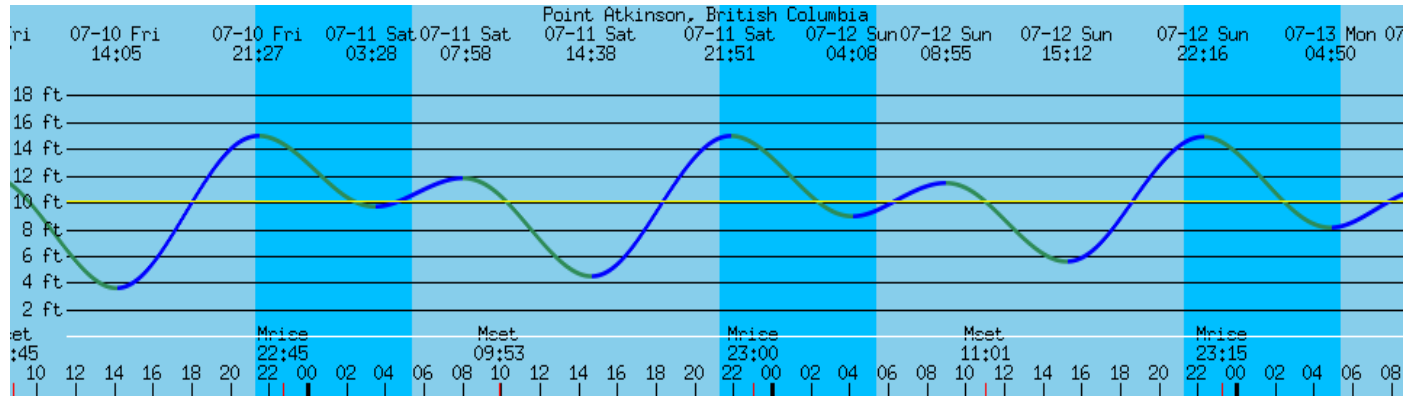
## **9 FEES**
