- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 except as specifically noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association will apply except as specifically noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The class rules of each class will apply, except any of those altered by the sailing instructions.
- 1.4 Official Sailing Instructions will be the issued to competitors upon payment of registration fees. Any sailing instructions included in this Notice of Race may be modified up to and including time of registration.

2 ENTRIES

Additional classes wishing to participate should notify the Club by e-mail at kitsilano_yachtclub@telus.net no later than Monday June 28, 2011. An X-Class may be started at the discretion of the PRO. Portsmouth ratings will NOT be applied to X-Class participants.

- 2.2 Boats may be entered in this regatta by completing registration and payment of fees before 1100 Saturday, July 9th, 2011, at the Kitsilano Yacht Club (KYC). Registration is open Thursday, July 7th between 2000 and 2200 and Saturday, July 9th between 0930 and 1100 hours.
KYC can accept payment in Canadian cash, US cash at par, or Canadian cheque.

- 2.3 Entrants must be a member in good standing of their Fleet's Class Association, a Club recognized by their National Authority, and of the Canadian Yachting Association or the corresponding national authority of the entrant's home club.
- 2.4 KYC reserves the right to refuse entry of any person or boat by refunding money paid upon registration.
- 2.5 All those taking part in the racing do so at their own risk and responsibility. The hosting organization is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a yacht or for the safety of those whose entry is accepted. Attention of the competitor is drawn to RRS Part 1, Fundamental Rule 4.

6 SCHEDULE – REGISTRATION, RACING & SOCIAL

6.1 Registration:

Thursday, July 7th between 2000 and 2200 and Saturday, July 9th between 0930 and 1100 hours.

6.2 Racing:

The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race each day will be:

Saturday July 9, 2011 – 1200 hrs

Sunday July 10, 2011 – 1100 hrs

No warning signal will be made later than 1530 on Sunday, July 10.

Door prizes will be awarded by random draw before/during dinner on Saturday. All registered skippers and crew are eligible.

6 CLASSES

7.1 Classes with five or more entries will be scored separately

7.2 One X Class made up of those Classes that have fewer than five entries may be permitted to race at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer. No handicap scoring will be applied.

8 PRIZES

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to each member of the crews placing first, second and third.

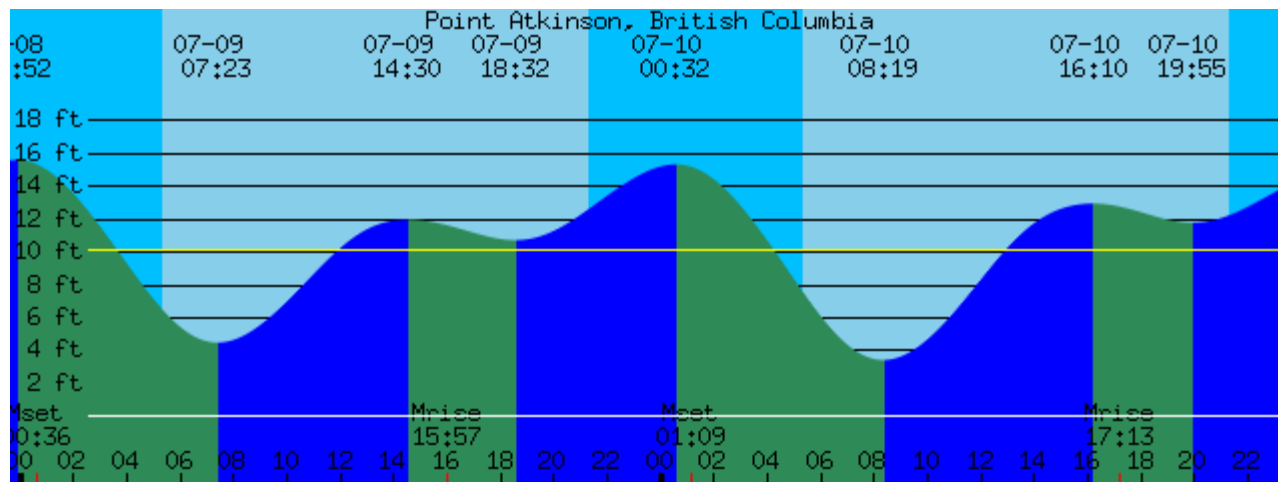
9 FEES
