A minimum of 5 entries in a class is required for a strat. An X-Class may be started at the discretion of the PRO. Portsmouth ratings will NOT be applied to X-Class participants.

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 except as specifically noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association will apply except as specifically noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The class rules of each class will apply, except any of those altered by the sailing instructions.
- 1.4 Official Sailing Instructions will be issued to competitors upon payment of registration fees. Any sailing instructions included in this Notice of Race may be modified up to and including time of registration.

2 ENTRIES

- 2.1 This is a One Design event open to One Design Fleets. Local Fleet representatives should email fleetcaptain@kitsilanoyachtclub.com or call the Club at (604) 730-1646 no later than Monday October 26 to express the level of interest within their Fleet and to request a start. A minimum of 5 entries in a class is required for a strat. An X-Class may be started at the discretion of the PRO. Portsmouth ratings will NOT be applied to X-Class participants.
- 2.2 Participation must be confirmed by completing registration and payment of fees before 1030 Saturday, November 7, 2009, at the Kitsilano Yacht Club (KYC). The Registration desk is open Saturday, November 7, 2009 between 0900 and 1030 hours. Sailors under age 19 must have signed approval of parent or guardian to participate. Registration forms will be available at www.kitsilanoyachtclub.com by November 1, 2009
- 2.3 Entrant must be a member in good standing of both their Fleet's Class Association, a Club recognized by their National Authority, and of the Canadian Yachting Association or the

corresponding national authority of the entrant's home club.

2.4 KYC reserves the right to refuse entry of any person or boat by refunding money paid upon registration.

2.5 All those taking part in the racing do so at their own risk and responsibility. The hosting organization is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a yacht or for the safety of those whose entry is accepted. Attention of the competitor is drawn to RRS Part 1, Fundamental Rule 4.

3 SCHEDULE – REGISTRATION, RACING & SOCIAL

3.1 Registration:

The Registration desk is open Saturday, November 7, 2009 between 0900 and 1030 hours. Sailors under age 19 must have signed approval of parent or guardian to participate. Registration forms are available at www.kitsilano-yachtclub.com

3.2 Racing:

The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race each day will be:

Saturday November 7, 2009 – 1200 hrs

Sunday November 8, 2009 – 1200 hrs

A maximum of nine (9) races will be run.

No warning signal will be made later than 1500 on Sunday, November 8.

3.3 Social & Food

Coffee, bagels etc. available Saturday morning.

Door prizes will be awarded by random draw after racing on Saturday. All registered skippers and crew are eligible. Winners must be present to win.

Hot Chili, fresh bread will be available as soon as sailors are off the water on Saturday.

This is included in the price of registration for all sailors. Additional Chili tickets are available at \$10 each.

4 CLASSES

Classes with five or more entries will be scored separately

One X Class made up of those Classes that have fewer than five entries may be permitted to race at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer. No handicap scoring will be applied.

5 PRIZES

5.1 Prizes will be awarded to each member of the crews placing first, second and third.

6 FEES

25\$ for Single handed boats (Includes 1 chilli ticket)

35\$ for Double handed boats (Includes 2 chilli tickets)

45\$ for Triple handed boats (Includes 3 chilli tickets)

Fees must be paid at time of registration. KYC can accept payment in Canadian cash, US cash at par or Canadian cheque
