1. LOCATION & GOVERNING AUTHORITY

1.1 Location

1.2 The race series will be governed by the rules as defined in the racing rules of sailing 2009-2012 with the exception of course signals. These will be the standard KYC signals rather than the standard international signals.

1.3 The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association will apply except where otherwise noted. The class rules of each class will apply except where altered by the sailing instructions.

1.4 Competitors are encouraged to request modifications to the race series format or basically anything they feel needs improvement in the race series and all reasonable requests will be accommodated.

1.5 Dates: Sept 17th, Sept 24th, Lawrence Cup on Sunday Oct 2nd, Oct 8th, Oct 15th

2. ENTRIES

2.1. This event is open to all dinghies and keel boats. Each class of boats will be scored against their own class regardless of the number of boats registering, even if all classes start together.

2.2 Entrant must be a member in good standing of both their Fleet's Class Association, a Club recognized by their National Authority, and of the Canadian Yachting Association or the corresponding national authority of the entrant's home club.

2.3 All those taking part in the racing do so at their own risk and responsibility. The hosting organization is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a yacht or for the safety of those whose entry is accepted. Attention of the competitor is drawn to RRS Part 1, Fundamental Rule

3 SCHEDULE, RACING, REGISTRATION and SOCIAL

3.1 Registration: Competitors register by hailing the race committee boat with their sail number at any time after the RC whaler has dropped its anchor.

3.2 Racing: First Signal will be at 12:30 P.M. Last signal will be at 3:00 P.M. Course length will be similar to Thursday night racing.

3.3 See attached document for details of the race courses. The RC whaler may leave a float in its position in the event that other other marks need adjustment while the competitors are racing. Minimal adjustments of the course will be made after the first start signal.

3.4 Code Flag 1 (Japan) will indicate a once around course. Code flag 2 (the other one) will indicate a twice around course.

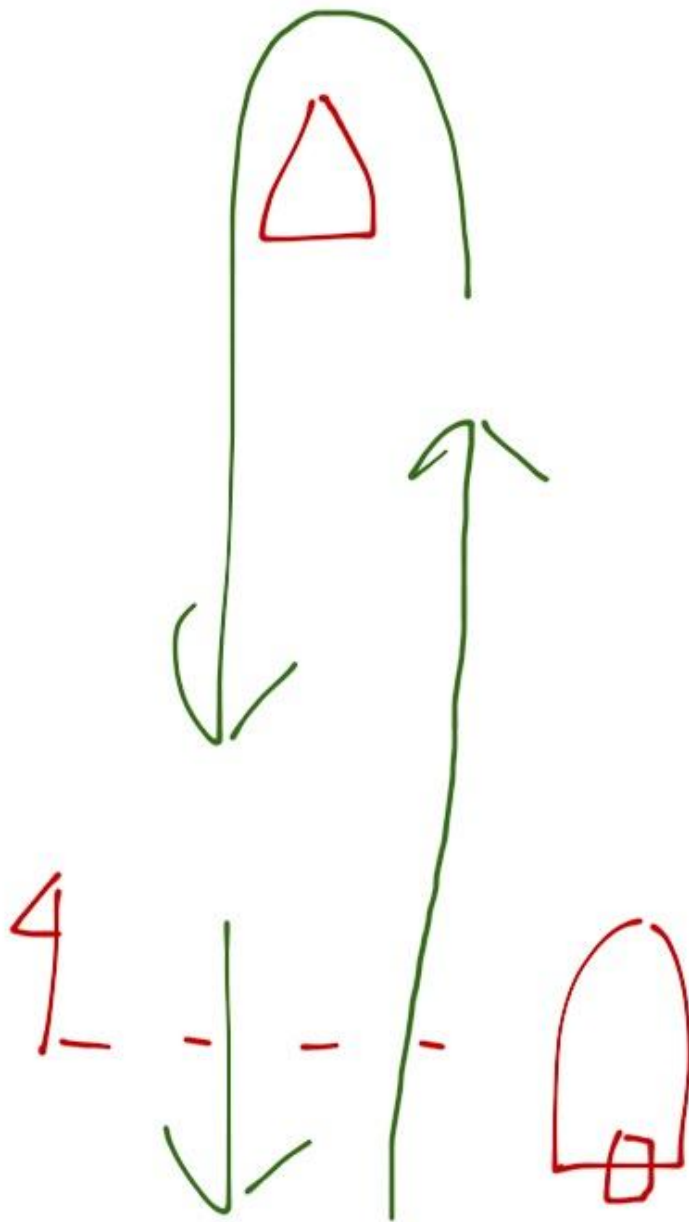
4. PRIZES and FEES
